Petra Community Housing (PCH) was founded in 1994 by the Greater Phoenixville Area Council of Churches to provide solutions for the lack of affordable housing in the area. Since its inception PCH has assisted over 30 families in their dream to become first-time homeowners and renovated three local factories into affordable housing for low income seniors and adults with disabilities. SteelTown Village, the newest Petra property, is located in Phoenixville and provides affordable housing for families, seniors, veterans and disabled.

Petra has a reputation for taking excellent care of their facilities and serving their residents as more than a landlord. A committed maintenance staff keeps the buildings and outdoor spaces in excellent condition while dedicated Resident Service Coordinators assist the residents in securing needed services and benefits.

Making a Difference:

The Petra on the Go is a bus program for residents of Petra managed properties and provides the benefit of affordable transportation for the residents of our elderly and disabled buildings. During the Covid Pandemic this program was suspended due to the many limiting and changing protocols and restrictions put in place to protect our residents and staff.

With most of the Covid restrictions reduced and or removed, Petra on the Go has restarted operations and over the last few months has returned to regular use thanks in part to a volunteer driver. I was deeply moved recently when a resident shared how this program has provided them a restored sense of independence to be able to get out and shop at an extremely affordable price.

As we restart this program for 2022-2023, we need your support to assist Petra in covering the operating costs of the Mini Bus for the next 12 months. The projected cost to operate the Mini Bus for this period is approximately \$7,000. Residents pay \$2.00 per trip which covers the cost of gas.

In order to cover the operational costs we are asking you to partner with Petra by purchasing a Banner Ad for the side of the bus or by making a donation to the Petra on the Go program. There are four Banner Ads available for purchase. The Ads are professionally designed and installed on the side of the bus which regularly travels between Spring City and the its neighboring towns.
